Computer Technical Requirements for Live Remote Proctoring (LRP)

CMCI utilizes <u>PSI Bridge</u> for LRP. In order to take the Certified Construction Manager[®] (CCM[®]) exam through PSI Bridge, CMCI recommends using a personal computer that meets the requirements below.

PSI Bridge is compatible with any modern Windows or Mac OS X computers with a working webcam, microphone, and internet connection. PSI's compatibility check tool will ensure the candidate's system meets the following technical requirements (hardware and software) for their remote proctored exam:

- **Operating system supported**: Windows 7 and later; 32bit (x86) and 64bit (x64); Mac OS X and later.
- **Browsers supported**: PSI Secure Lock-Down Browser To be downloaded within 30 minutes of test being delivered.
- **Browser settings**: The browser must accept third-party cookies for the duration of the exam ONLY.
- Webcam/microphone: Minimum VGA 640 x 480 resolution, enabled built-in or external microphone.
- Bandwidth: Minimum 400 kb/s download and upload.
- Hardware requirements: 2GB RAM Memory; 1 GB Free Disk Space, minimum 1368x768 screen resolution.

If your personal computer does not meet the requirements outlined above, CMCI highly recommends scheduling your CCM exam at a <u>PSI Testing Center</u>.
